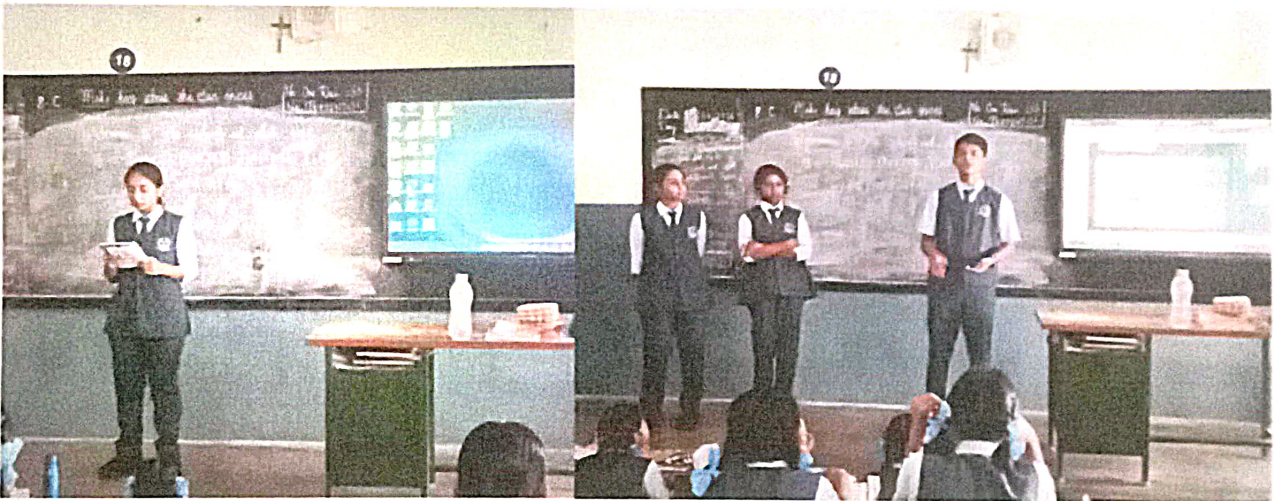

The club is guided by the motto Debate, Diplomacy and Leadership.

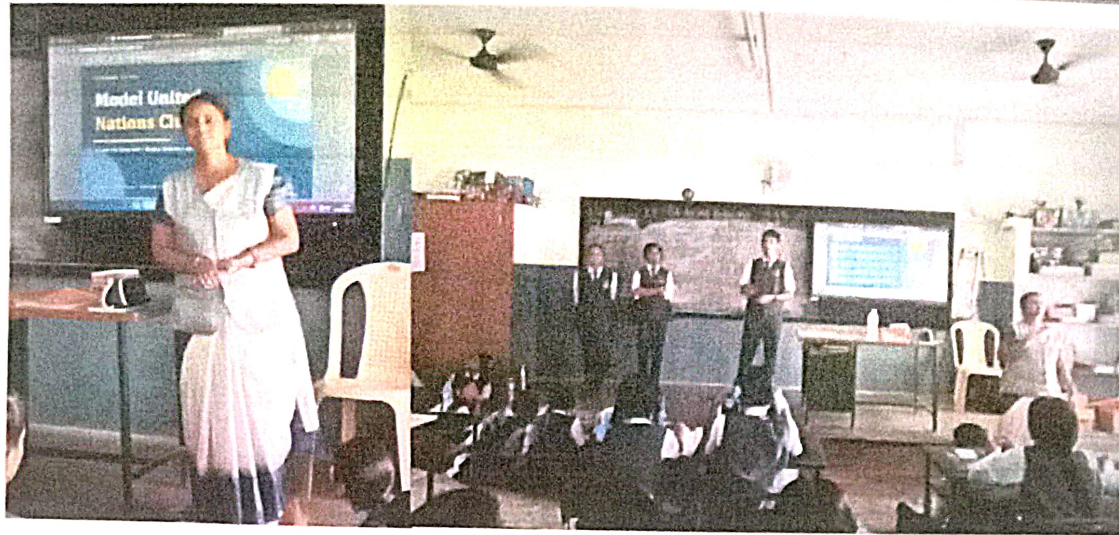
The main objectives of the club are:-


The theme for the academic year 2026–2027 was formally announced:


