The National Green Corps (NGC) is one of India's largest school-based environmental movements initiated by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, by Government of India.

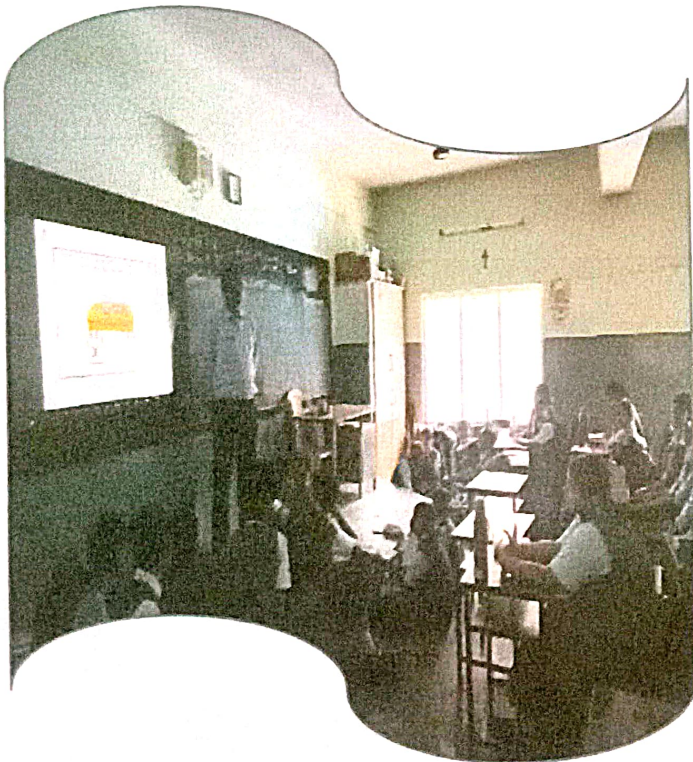
